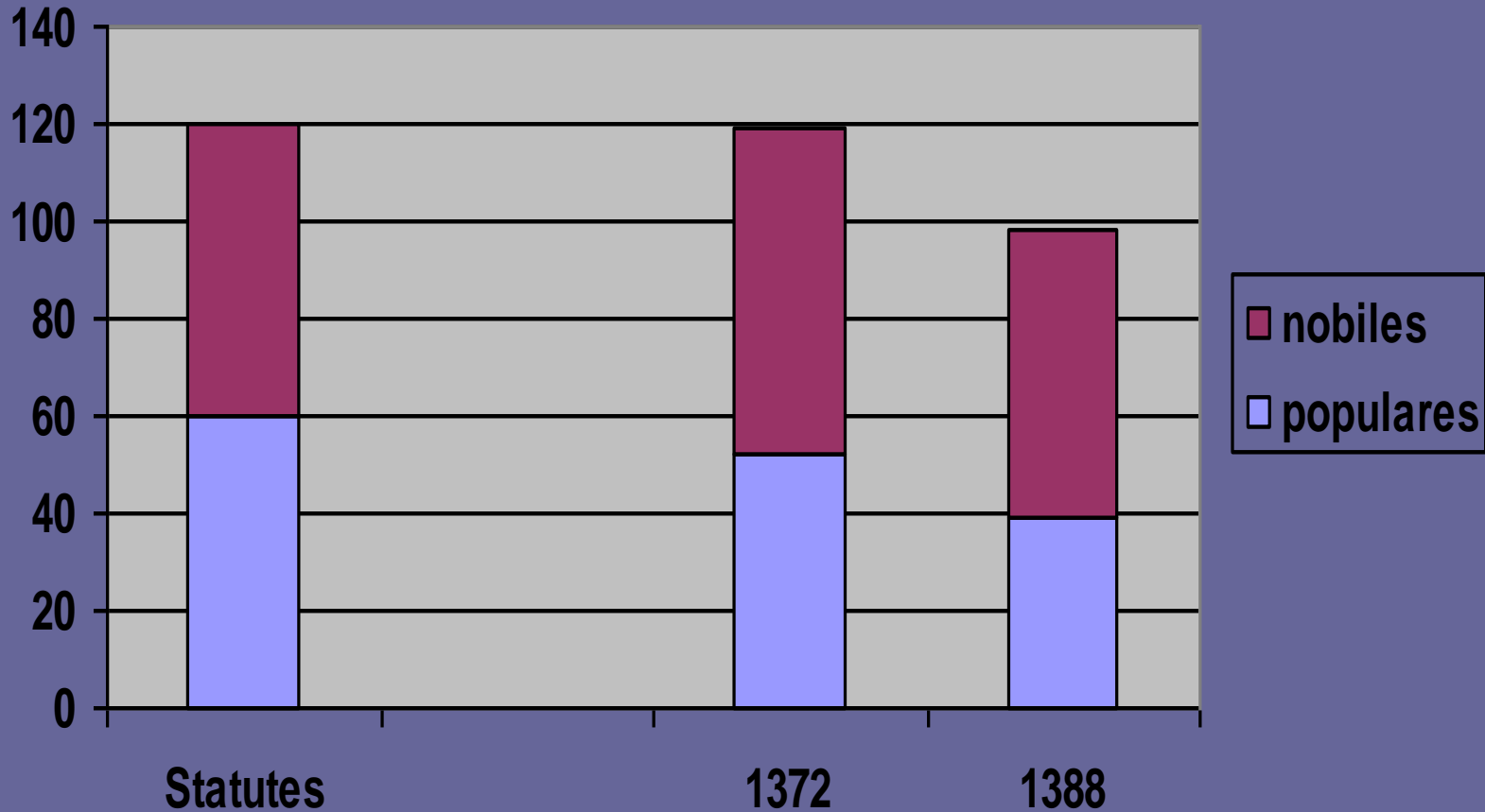
Rab in the 14th Century: the Commune

Rab in 14th Century: the nobles

- **a) lineages that function now as founding branches of the ancient Rab noble lineages because of the stability at that time of the family names (and later surnames) in the 14th century:**
 -
 - Domine, (Dominis), Forma, Gauzigna (Galzigna), Hermolais, Poruga, Zaro and Zudenico (Zudenigo);
- **b) lineages whose name had developed or was developing from patronyms, which seem to us today to have functioned as secondary branches of old Rab noble families, sharing part of their ancestors in common with the above-mentioned lineages:**
 -
 - Bernaba, Borre, Georgiis, that is, Flascono, Grube, Martinussio, Slovigna and Phillipio; and,
- **c) progeny of members of foreign noble lineages who settled on Rab (who had become Rab *cives* before acceptance of the Statute):**
 -
 - Cernotta (and Domaldo, as what seems a secondary branch) and Spalatin.
